



# WELCOME! PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES

WE SEEK TO LOVE GOD IN ALL WE DO AND SAY, LOVING OUR NEIGHBORS AS OURSELVES. BELOW ARE A SOME RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION THAT HELP MAKE LIFE AROUND HERE ENJOYABLE AND POSSIBLE.

- Office Hours (Pay Bill): 8 am- 5 pm. Canteen Hours (Register and buy canteen items): 8 am- 7 pm.
- You are welcome to camp Friday night. Please plan to arrive after 3:00pm. We will not be able to accommodate anyone staying in the lodges Friday night.
- Every family unit—whether staying here or just coming for the day—must register online or at the office as soon as possible, regardless of who is paying.
- Avoid a long check-out line by paying your bill before Thursday or Friday.
- The pool hours are 10:30-11:30 am and 1:00-5:00 pm Late night swims need to be prearranged by Prince Road elders. Baptisms any time!!
- Please use water conservatively — Our pump can handle this week, but it cannot handle abuse this week.
- Non-emergency messages will be posted on the bulletin board outside the office door. We will try to deliver emergency messages.
- Please take your full bags of trash and soda cans to the trash trailer.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 8 am — Please be respectful and allow each other to get some sleep.
- If you are the last to leave the pavilion or meeting rooms, please turn off the lights.
- We will close all bathrooms from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m. for thorough cleaning. This means they are not available for use. This is our only opportunity to clean them, so please plan accordingly.
- For your safety, please wear shoes at all times.
- Vehicle safety: 5 mph speed limit, the main loop is one way (counter clockwise); do not park right beside office.
- No fireworks.
- Fire safety: Please place fires at least 20 ft. from trees, in metal rings. Do not leave fires unattended. Burn only dead, downed wood. Please do not burn any wood that is split and stacked by the buildings.
- Please do not sit, walk, or lie on E Hwy at night. The locals drive particularly fast!
- Use the activity field in the hollow for running sports and the walking trails around camp for exercise. Don't drive on them.
- Please keep away from the ropes courses and climbing wall. Lounging on them is damaging, and they are dangerous without proper equipment and supervision. If a group of 6 or more would like to schedule a session in the ropes courses, climbing wall, caving, etc., please contact office ASAP.
- If you find yellow jackets or wasps please report to the office, especially if you have located their nest.
- Dogs are allowed on camp, but must be on a leash, kept quiet, and cleaned up after. This means cleaning up your pets' messes! No pets allowed in buildings.
- Charges for repairs or replacement will be assessed and billed to camper.
- **In case of emergency:** If you call 911, while you are waiting please notify someone at the office during the day and at one of the staff homes at night. Also, consider that many of our staff members have some medical training and may be able to assist you.
